



DEPUTY DIRECTOR, EDUCATION

The California Science Center seeks a Deputy Director, Education to lead its education division (Amgen Center for Science Learning) at an exciting time.

The California Science Center has recently completed construction of a \$55 million facility that includes new facilities for the Center for Science Learning and a charter neighborhood elementary school that has a curriculum focused on science. The Science Center School, developed in partnership with the Los Angeles Unified School District, opened with its first class of 700 students in September. It is designed to serve as a model elementary school, which together with the new Amgen Center for Science Learning facilities and the California Science Center's exhibits will serve as the core of an expanded professional development program.

The Deputy Director, Education will also play a pivotal role in establishing new programs relating to the Science Center's next major exhibit expansion – World of Ecology. World of Ecology will introduce guests to the science of ecology through a unique mix of live animals and living habitats with hands on exhibits.

The Deputy Director, Education will report directly to the President and will be responsible for the development, implementation, and evaluation of all educational policies and programs for the California Science Center. The qualified candidate will be a creative thinker who is dedicated to devising innovative programs for science learning and must share in the passion and vision of the organization.

The successful candidate will be able to provide leadership in a collaborative work environment, must have demonstrated ability to guide, develop and manage educational programs for the public and science education professionals, and experience working with formal educational institutions.

Qualifications include an earned doctorate and/or masters and at least 5 years experience in an academic or museum/science center administrative position.
